

Cley Parish Council's Chairman's Report January 2025

The speed detector, (SAM2), was most recently on Glandford Road with an average speed of 28.1mph and average daily count of 360 cars. It was also on Holt Road again and recorded an average speed of 24.6mph and 1100 cars per day (in just one direction). We're looking at the possibility of replacing our batteries with solar powered ones to make life easier. We will next position the SAM2 to capture data on cars travelling towards the green from the village.
